

Texas HB 2819

What is HB 2819?

Texas House Bill 2819 requires state agencies to develop, procure, maintain and use electronic and information technology that is accessible to people with disabilities. Passed by the 79th Texas State legislature, HB 2819 adds Subchapter E as an amendment to Texas Government Code 2054.118 - that part of the code that regulates the purchase and management of information technology resources for the state. The [Coalition of Texans with Disabilities](#) fostered the passage of the bill, it was signed into law by Governor Perry on June 17th 2005, and it will go into effect on September 1, 2005.

Provisions allow an agency to provide the information or service by means of alternative methods if it is determined that it would create an "undue burden," or require significant difficulty or expense to comply.
